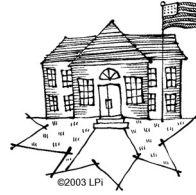

Rwanda News Below is a part of a letter Fr. Bill received from Fr. Joseph, MIC, the Director of the Association of Marian Helpers:



I am writing on behalf of Fr. Leszek and all of our Marian missionaries in Rwanda to thank you and the parishioners of St. Peter's for once again welcoming Fr. Leszek to your parish. Thank you also for your outpouring of support. I know that many of the parishioners feel a connection to the mission in Rwanda, and the missionaries are encouraged by this.

Your material help is also a blessing. The offerings of \$12,128.00, will help pay for the new water line and cistern, which are so vital.

You and all the parishioners of St. Peter's are remembered in Holy Mass on the First Saturday of each month offered at the chapel in CANA. Also, on November 28th, when we celebrated the anniversary of the first apparition of Our Lady of Kibeho, Father Leszek remembered you and your special intentions at Mass.

Please continue to pray that our work in Kibeho will bear the fruit of healing for the many souls hurt by the genocide that devastated Rwanda and will lead many souls into a deeper relationship with Christ Our Lord and Savior.
