On most Sundays the doors are closed after the 11 am Mass or Baptisms and reopened at 6 pm.

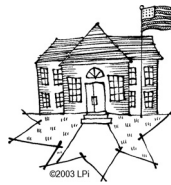
Heart Saver AED Recertification Training
