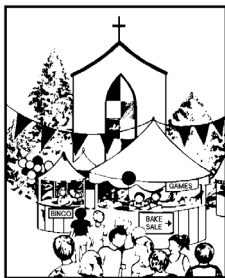

If you are a parishioner and you haven't found a way to be involved yet, check out the sign up board in the lobby. There are plenty of spaces open for volunteers!

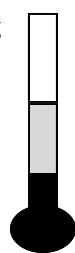
Raffle tickets are also available in the lobby. We've sold 220 books so far. Pick some up for a chance to win great prizes!

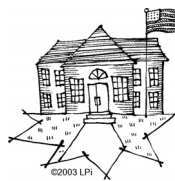
