Dear God, you are even stronger than death. Help me to have faith in you like Jairus had. Amen.

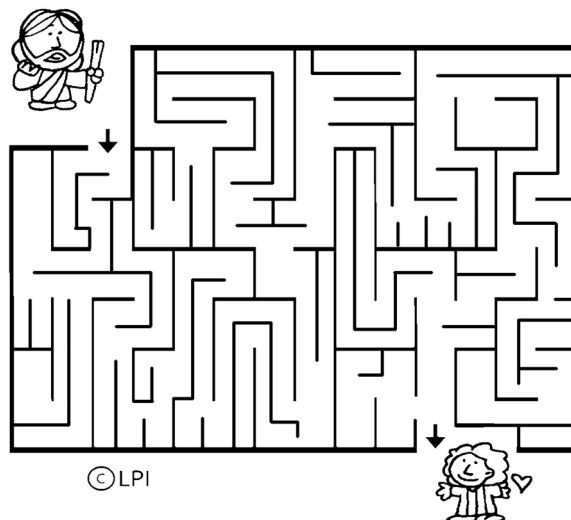
