St. Peter Youth Choir The youth choir will meet on Sundays, February 14 and 28 at 10:30 am to rehearse and then sing for the 11 am Mass.

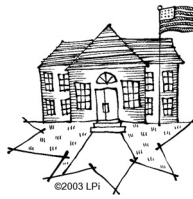
Our Lady of Guadalupe Image St. Peter Parish is honored to be on the visitation schedule for the "Our Lady of Guadalupe Missionary Image" for the Milwaukee Archdiocese on Saturday, February 27, 2010.

This is a digital replica, exact in size and color, of the original miraculous image that Our Lady left on Saint Juan Diego's Tilma in 1531. It is certified by Cardinal Norberto Rivera Carrera, Archbishop of Mexico.

Monsignor Diego Monroy, Vicar General and Rector of the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, blessed this missionary image and prayed for the success of our Lady's mission to bring a culture of life, sanctity of the family, solidarity of the church in American and a civilization of love.

Please join us on Saturday to begin the day with the rosary at 7:30 am followed by 8am Mass and the Divine Mercy Chaplet afterward. Visitation will be throughout the day with the rosary again at 4:30 pm, 5pm Mass and the Divine Chaplet afterward. During the visitation you are encouraged to pray, say the rosary, to come forward to venerate the Image by touching, kissing, and placing your religious articles on the Image. World Marriage Day Today is World Marriage Day. The idea of celebrating marriage began in Baton Rouge, La., in 1981, when couples encouraged the Mayor, the Governor and the Bishop to proclaim St. Valentine's Day as "We Believe in Marriage Day". The event was so successful, the idea was presented to and was adopted by Worldwide Marriage Encounter's National Leadership. By 1982, 43 Governors officially proclaimed the day, and celebrations spread to U.S. military bases in several foreign countries. In 1983, the name was changed to "World Marriage Day", designated to be celebrated each year on the second Sunday in February. In 1993, his Holiness, Pope John Paul II, imparted his Apostolic Blessings on World Marriage Day.
