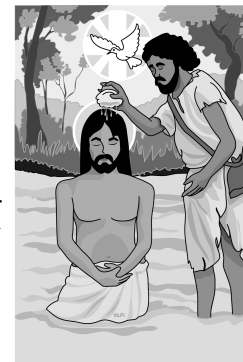

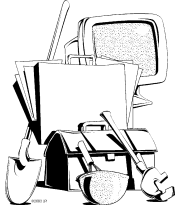

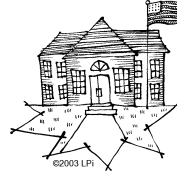

**St. Peter School News** Tuesday was the feast day of Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first American-born saint. In Archbishop Listecki's homily, he had this to say about Elizabeth Ann Seton. "There was nothing easy about her life. The sickness and death of her spouse, her conversion and rejection by her family, a single mother educating her children and raising them in the faith. The world would easily have justified her cursing her lot in life. Yet this woman, armed with her faith, begins the Catholic School system, establishes a religious order and shapes the Catholic Church in the United States for the next century. What generates this kind of dedicated commitment? It is a confidence in God." In Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton's own words, "...God calls us to a holy life. We know that he gives us every grace, every abundant grace; and though we are so weak of ourselves, this grace is able to carry us through every obstacle and difficulty."
