

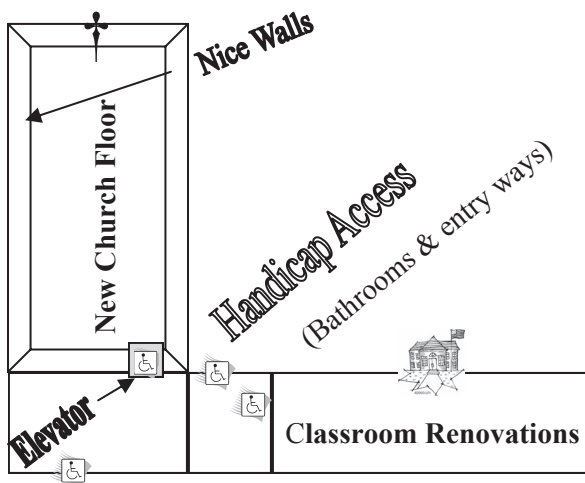

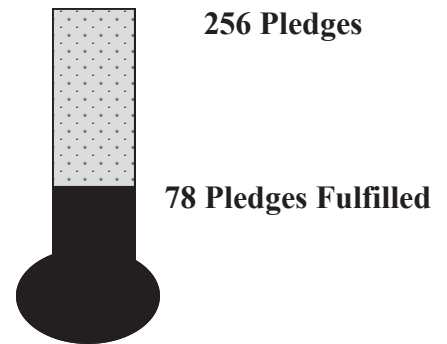

We are proud of the members and guests who do dress appropriately for Sunday Mass. Thank you for the respect which you show Sunday after Sunday to God and His People.

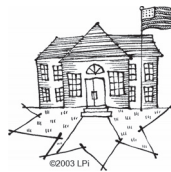
