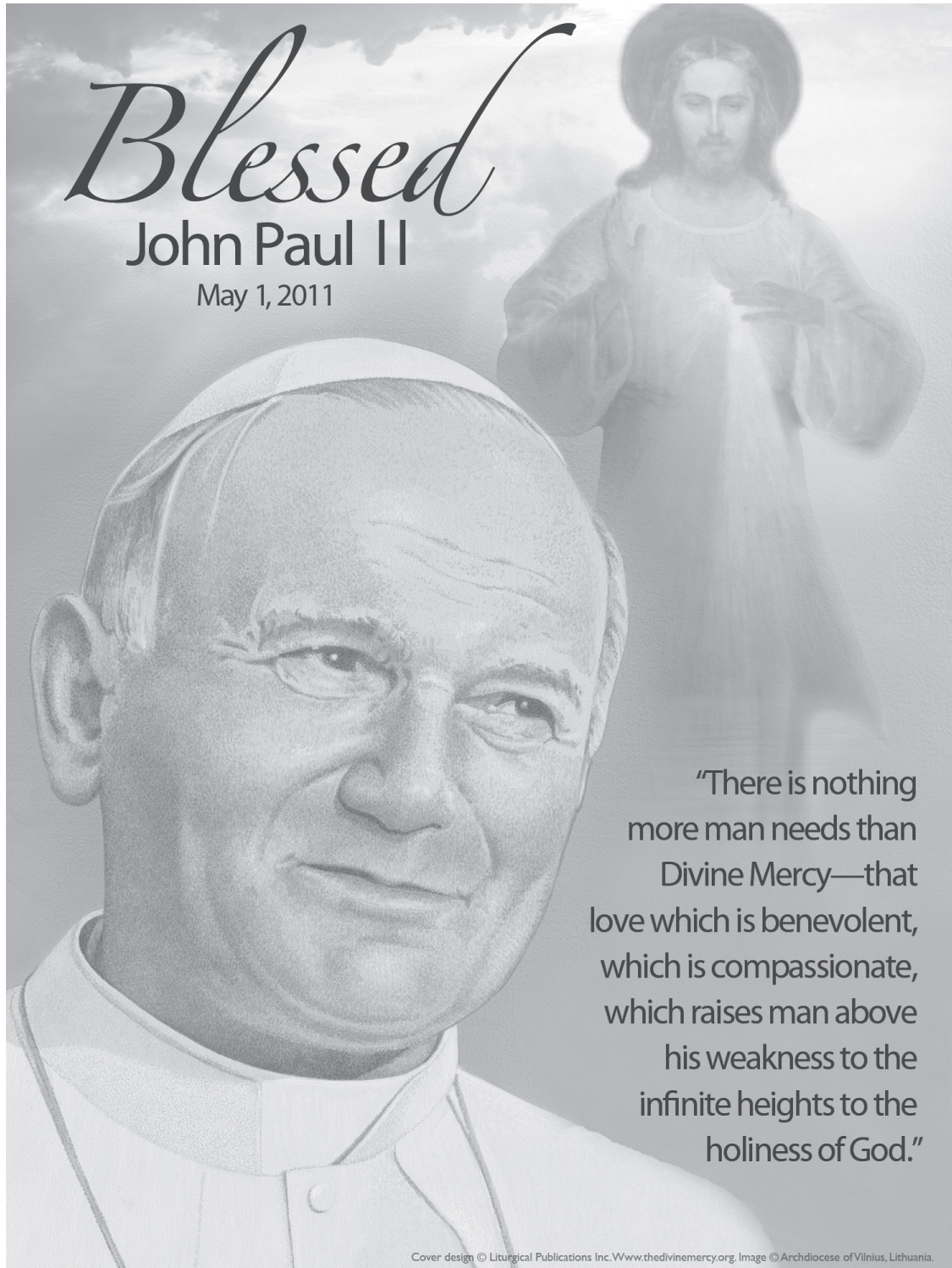

**Our Blessed Mother's Intercession** Prayer to Our Blessed Mother Mary has been part of the practices of the Church since its earliest days. For example, found on a 3rd Century papyrus in Egypt, the Sub Tuum prayer calls on Our Lady for her protection and intercession for the petitioner's needs.

On earth, we ask those still among us to pray for us and our intentions. They become our intercessors. We also can ask for the prayers of our family who have already entered into eternal life. Because they are united more closely with God, their prayers are more efficacious.

It's little wonder that we offer our prayers through the Blessed Virgin Mary, whom the Angel Gabriel greeted as "full of grace" (Lk 1:28). When we offer our prayers through Mary, she can add her superabundant grace to them to make them more efficacious and acceptable to God.

This month at St. Peter's we will venerate Our Lady after all the Masses by praying a litany. We will also honor her by praying the rosary before daily Masses at 7:30 am as we always do and on Wednesdays at 10:50 am the school children will pray the rosary together in Church. All are welcome. **Mary, Mother of God, pray for us!**

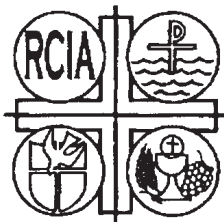

### Blessed John Paul II...pray for us

Beatification (from Latin *beatus*, blessed, via Greek *μακάριος*, *makarios* and Latin *facere*, make) is a recognition accorded by the Catholic Church of a dead person's entrance into Heaven and capacity to intercede on behalf of individuals who pray in his or her name (intercession of saints). Beatification is the third of the four steps in the canonization process. A person who is beatified is given the title "Blessed".

This Sunday the Church celebrates the beatification of Pope John Paul II. We celebrate with the whole Church this most joyous of occasions.
