**School News** Archbishop Jerome Listecky has approved the foundation of All Saints' Catholic School, which will operate two complete K-4 – 8 campuses at the former St. Mary and Holy Rosary grammar school locations. The outgoing members of the school's Steering Committee selected Jacqueline Lichter, Ph.D. as the school's lead principal, and they have asked Mr. Bruce Varick to serve as All Saints' associate principal. Dr. Lichter has taught throughout the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, developed curriculum, supervised instruction, and served as chairman of the Theology Department at Pius XI High School in Milwaukee. This is her first assignment as a principal. Archbishop Jerome Listecky has encouraged Catholic parents in our area to consider All Saints' Catholic School. He believes that it is never too late to consider enrolling in a Catholic elementary school, regardless of a student's grade level. Parents who are active parishioners at one of the ten supporting churches can anticipate that tuition for one child will be \$2,550.00 and a \$300.00 school fee will be assessed for books, athletics, and technology expenses. Tuition for non-parishioners is \$3,050.00 in addition to the \$300.00 school fee. Watch for updates.
